

## Demographics

Many of the health indicators in the 2005 Iowa Health Fact Book are presented with rates calculated using the population of the county and state. These rates are also stratified into population subgroups based on their 2004 county populations. This not only contrasts the rural and urban aspects of the state but also includes trends in age and ethnic distribution of the population. The Year 2000 US standard population age distribution is used for calculating age-adjusted rates. Population estimates have been obtained from the US Census via the National Cancer Institute's SEER\*Stat software program. Estimates are used for each year and year groupings where appropriate.

Using the 2004 county populations, there were 20 counties with less than 10,000 residents, 38 counties with 10,000 to 20,000 residents, 21 counties with 20,000 to

50,000 residents, and 20 Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) counties. The distribution of the population by age is different among the county groupings. The larger counties have a greater percentage of their population as young adults (15-44 years) compared to the smaller counties. Conversely, the smaller counties have a larger percentage of persons 65 years of age or older. These differences in age distributions are standardized through age-adjustment so risk factors other than age can be compared. As shown, the population of the state has become older since 1970. The percent of Iowans age 65 and older increased steadily through the early 1990's, but has slightly decreased since then.

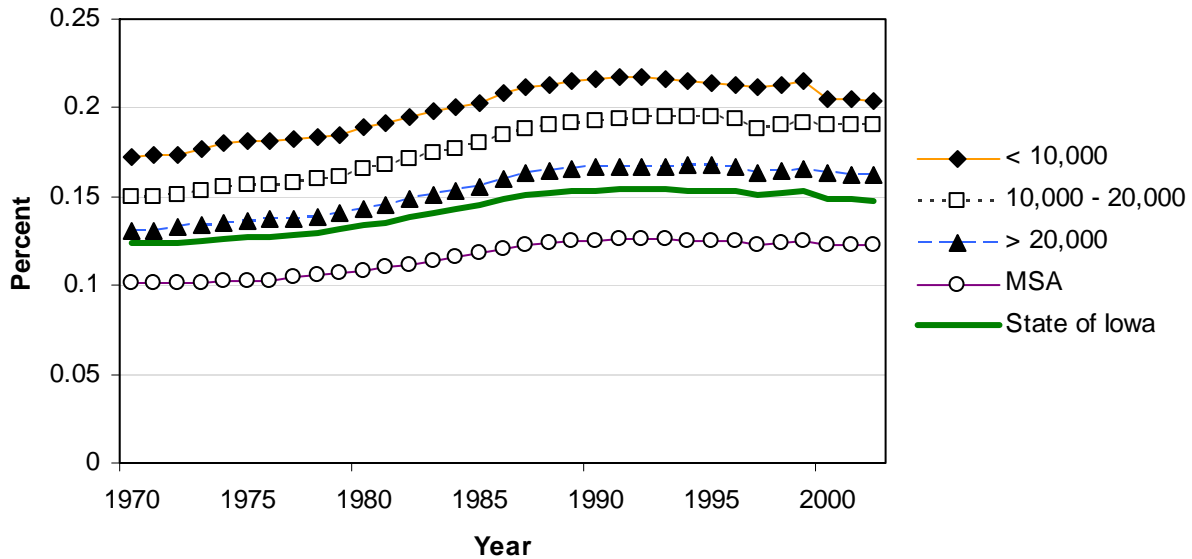
