The Department of Occupational and Environmental Health at The University of Iowa College of Public Health invites applications for a tenure track faculty position in Industrial Hygiene at the level of Professor or Associate Professor.

The University of Iowa offers a rich environment for collaborative research including a NIOSH-funded Agricultural Health Center, an NIEHS-funded Environmental Health Sciences Research Center, a CDC-funded Injury Prevention Research Center, a Superfund Basic Research Program, and a NIOSH-funded Healthier Workforce Center for Excellence. The Industrial Hygiene program provides training for both masters and doctoral level students, is supported by the NIOSH-funded Heartland Center for Occupational Health and Safety, and is fully accredited by ABET. Industrial Hygiene faculty members in the department have established research in exposure assessment and control, ergonomics, aerosol physics, and, toxicology.

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. or other doctorate in industrial hygiene or a relevant science or engineering field. Experience with agricultural and/or rural populations and eligibility for CIH certification are desirable. Successful candidates will have a solid publication record and have demonstrated the ability to obtain extramural research funding. Applicants must also demonstrate excellence in teaching and mentoring. The successful applicant will be expected to teach graduate courses in industrial hygiene, direct graduate thesis research, and develop an extramurally-funded research program.
