Reciprocity


An approach to research that focuses on shared goals and responsibility of the research project

Accountability

The commitment to providing justification for or information about decisions that are made



We value partnerships in which all parties are responsible for their own actions and mutually held to a high standard in order to achieve shared goals and objectives



Reciprocity is a "colearning and empowering process that facilitates the reciprocal transfer of knowledge, skills, capacity, and power"
