### Elections

### GPSG/GSS

- Steps to become a university recognized organization again are in place
  - By becoming a recognized organization, we will have a voice in student government, access to potential funding
    - Alternative: become a part of GSS (represents all grad students except professional students)
      - 4 delegates from GSS are sent to GPSG
        - There is a chance CPHSA would not be represented by these delegates, and the funding would be less this route
      - GSS and GPSG would like to see CPH represented in both organizations
        - Currently there are students from the biostatistics department on GSS. We are under assumption that the goal for GSS is to have college-wide representatives
        - Potentially the incoming at large is the delegate, but it may be better to make the decision for this first year delegate based on personal interest and schedule availability
